Prior to class, you should...

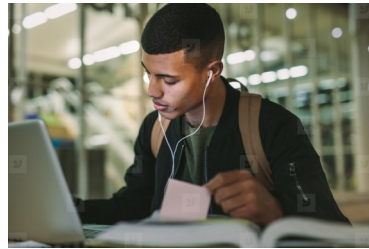
- Plug in and/or charge device
